Second Chance Living PMI works to improve the lives of justice-involved women in underserved communities by focusing on community resources that create measurable impact in workforce development, mental health, and reduce the probability of returning to prison.

Each year, more than **700,000** individuals are released from state and federal prisons.

Roughly **40%** of former federal prisoners and more than **60%** of former state prisoners are rearrested within three years of release.

It costs an average of **\$78.95** per day to keep an inmate locked up, the U.S. now spends more than \$68 billion annually on federal, state and local corrections.

Research suggests that ex-offenders who maintain a steady job and have close ties with family are less likely to renew their involvement in criminal behavior.

Successful reintegration into the workforce translates into:

- Safer neighborhoods,
- Stable families,
- Prosocial structured activity for an ex-offender,
- Reduced taxpayer costs for reincarceration,
- Living wages for an ex-offender to support himself/herself and family,
- Income for restitution to victims, court and correctional supervision fees
- Continued mental or behavioral health treatment, and child support, when necessary
